

# KARANJA PRO

## What is Karanja Oil?

Karanja oil is squeezed from the seeds of the karanja tree, and contains many useful compounds. **Karanja Pro** is made from seeds selected for the compound 'Karanjin', which acts as a miticide and insecticide.

As with all **Neem Pro** brand oils, our cold-press extraction process preserves all of the active compounds. **Karanja Pro** has 20,000ppm Karanjin, making it ideal for mixing into insecticidal sprays.

## How to Use:

**Karanja Pro** improves the effectiveness of foliar sprays and soil drenches. Combined with **Neem Pro 100%**, it creates a mix more powerful than the sum of its parts:

- maximum miticidal activity
- smoother mixing and spraying
- increased effectiveness overall



## Usage Tips and Recipes



Mites don't stand a chance.

**Karanja Pro** requires soap or other emulsifier to dissolve it into water. To add karanja to a spray containing other oils (such as neem), simply replace half that other oil with karanja and use the same total emulsifier.

### Neem+Karanja Foliar Spray:

- ¼ oz NeemPro
- ¼ oz KaranjaPro
- 1 ½ oz MOAP (or soap)
- 1 gallon water (128 oz = one gallon)



*A standard shot-glass is 1 ½ oz, so half a shot of each oil and one full shot of MOAP. Mix well, spray leaf top and bottom.*

### Karanja Soil Drench:

- 6 ½ oz KaranjaPro
- 6 ½ oz Moap (or soap)
- 5 gallons water

To reach soil-borne pests, carefully pour a solid stream of liquid into one spot in the center of the trouble site. Five gallons can easily soak 2-3 sites. Drenching works best when it's less than 85 degrees F, otherwise pests can be too deep to reach.
